

One of only three hospitals serving a population of more than 148,000, the state-of-the-art surgical center boasts 26 inpatient beds, an emergency room, and staffed by board-certified surgeons on staff. In a metroplex currently battling inequities in healthcare access, the facility represents as a vital link to medical care for local residents.

Saint Camillus was founded in 2016 to improve healthcare access in the densely populated northeastern corner of Tarrant County. The original facility was conceived as an in-patient hospital providing emergency services, surgical care, and diagnostic services. Since then, the facility has become the preferred destination for medical visits in the area, earning higher patient satisfaction ratings than other local medical facilities across multiple platforms.

The Hospital is one of two Dallas-Fort Worth area medical facilities recently acquired by the Houston-based Village Health system, as part of an ambitious expansion project that has quadrupled the size of the latter company within two years.

About Village Health: Village Health was originally founded to improve access to quality healthcare for suburban residents on the edge of the Houston metroplex. It carved a niche as a community medical facility with the expertise and quality of care rivaling larger, more established hospitals. Following the success and positive reputation of its first location, Spring Hospital, Village Health acquired The Heights Hospital in late 2021. Since then, the health system has expanded to eight new locations across Texas.

HEIGHTS IN-PATIENT DEPARTMENT

Each month, the Village Health newsletter highlights staff whose hard work and dedication allow our facilities to continue living up to their reputation for excellence in healthcare. This month, we highlight the Heights Hosptial In-Patient Department, who have embraced the challenge of caring for a growing number of patients with higher acuity level with grace and enthusiasm.

"We started with low patient acuity and maybe one to two inpatients a week last summer - that has changed," says Sana Farooqui, Director of Operations at The Heights Hospital. "At our high point in December, our staff was taking care of 17 patients and juggling discharges so all patients could be accommodated. Last week, they deftly managed seven admissions in one day."

Along with the volume, patient acuity has also increased. In the beginning, most patients were post-surgical, with relatively fast recovery. In recent months, however, a higher volume of more medically complex cases has flowed in. "It's been an ever-evolving challenge; the team has had to step out of their comfort zone, learn and build a bigger skill set," says Heather Anderson, Chief Nursing Officer for Village Health.

Rather than shy away from the challenge, the team has embraced it. Nurse Amir Ali says, "the hospital has given me freedom to gain new experience – there is opportunity to learn and opportunity for growth." Amir was recruited to the in-patient team from Pam Health by Hospitalist Dr. Nisarg "Nish" Patel as part of a larger effort to assemble an all-star staff.

"Dr. Patel is our main hospitalist. You will definitely find him sitting in the nursing station working on charts, or visiting patients," reports Sana. "He's been critical in getting our inpatient floor up and running. Despite being a doctor, he works with the inpatient department as part of a team."

Under the leadership of Dr. Patel, our inpatient staff has worked to implement protocols and processes that allow for easy coordination between patients-efforts which have not gone unnoticed. Cards from outgoing patients and their families adorn the wall of the inpatient unit. "As demanding as the floor has become," says Heather, "to maintain that level of



excellence just shows how well they work together as a team."

Our inpatient department – nurses and techs alike – are a very dedicated team. They work hard to cater to each patient and their family's individual needs. This may be another day of work for the inpatient unit, but it is a potentially traumatic day for the patient and their family; the nurses and techs are very aware of this, and make each patient feel unique.

"This isn't something you can keep doing if you aren't in love with what you do," says nurse Patricia Washington. "Being a kind, loving human being is important in any job - but especially this one."

Patricia refers to herself as an old-school nurse, following in her mother's footsteps. "My mother was a candy striper - I wanted to be a lawyer, but then a voice inside called me to nursing." She describes her nursing philosophy as rooted in the care-based approach of the past but informed by modern medical science.

When asked about her hopes for the hospital's future, she says "I would love to see the whole unit full. I know there are more people in Houston who can benefit from our kinder approach."

Village Health wishes to thank Heather, who as CNO was instrumental in bridging the gap between physicians and nurses and our inpatient techs (Yumvola, Daisy, Ashley G, Ashley B, Kai) who work alongside the nurses in caring for our patients. Hope to see all 40 beds completely filled up before the end of the year!

CCRI intends to bring clinical research to the patients who need it most, and by including the underserved in clinical research we believe we can advance the state of medicine for everyone.


Phase 3 study is currently enrolling to treat patients with **Degenerative Disc Disease.**
